NEHEN FHIR extends NEHEN's trusted exchange model to modern FHIR-based clinical and administrative APIs, helping payers, providers, and technology partners prepare for interoperability requirements. Shared infrastructure simplifies connectivity, reduces duplicate point-to-point integrations, and creates a common path for electronic prior authorization and clinical data exchange for quality measurement and reporting.

Massachusetts Market Momentum

Strong Payer Foundation: Four founding health plans are actively participating and collectively represent approximately 55% of covered lives in Massachusetts.

Expanding Network Reach: Beyond the initial Massachusetts participants, NEHEN is planning to incorporate national payer connectivity, enabling organizations to leverage a single connection model across a broader ecosystem of trading partners.

Provider Adoption Underway: Seven large provider organizations are in contracting, implementation planning, and EHR integration discussions. Discussions with additional provider organizations are underway as interest in network participation continues to grow.

Vendor Ecosystem Developing: Two major EHR vendors are already connected to the network and testing, creating a scalable pathway for provider organizations to accelerate onboarding. Discussions are underway with additional EHR vendors, and NEHEN portal access will be available for providers without FHIR-based systems.
